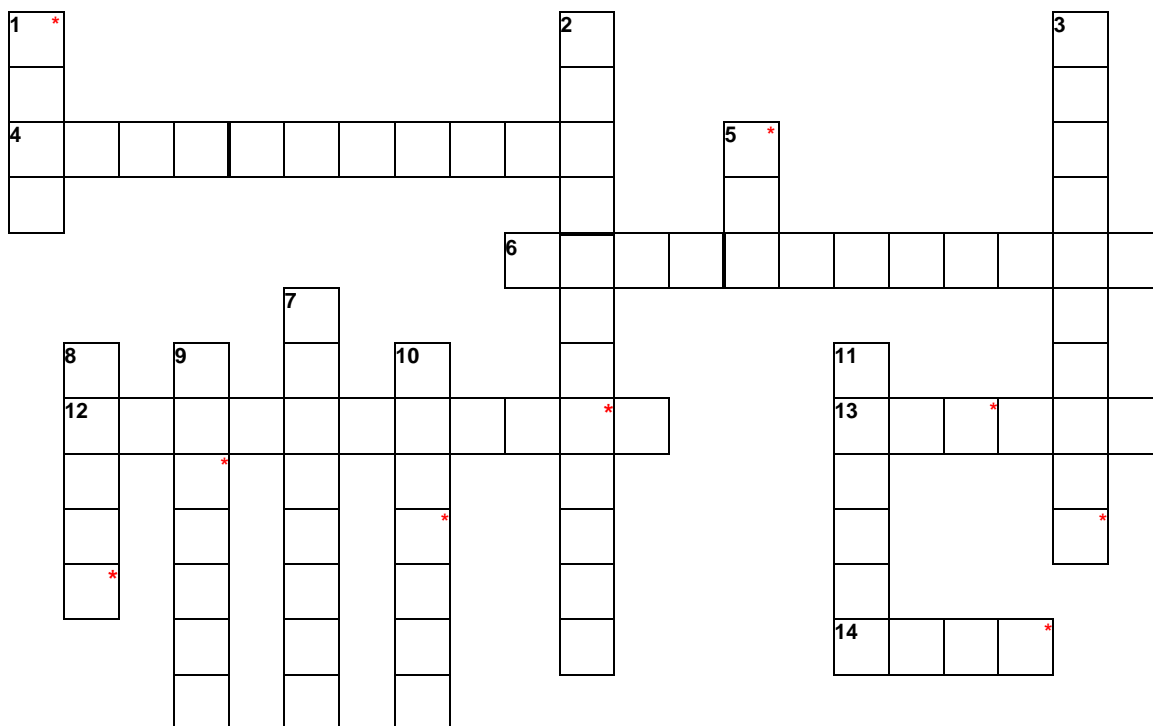
Solutions can be found in the resources following the puzzle. Of course, you can also use these resources when you want to dive deep into this topic to find out more.
